Construction of end wall on high tunnel hoop house. When the uprights are set, frame the bottom and the middle from the door frame to the 2-in. plastic rib pipe using 2x4s cut to size; refer to Figures 10 and 11 for examples. Then construct a door using 2x4s to fit into the door frame and attach with door hinges.

If you've ever built a hoop house, you know how difficult they can be to keep upright. We had to rebuild our hoop house twice before we made it sturdy enough to withstand high storms. I love this tutorial for building a 300 square foot hoop house for under \$500 because they use rebar to help hold the PVC pipe in place. This will allow your hoop house to withstand large gusts of wind and keep your hard work intact.

This low-cost, 30' long by 18' wide PVC high tunnel is constructed using PVC pipe for hoops. The materials cost roughly \$500 (including shade cloth for summer production) and we didn't shop for the best buy on materials and lumber.

### Constructing a Simple PVC High Tunnel - HighTunnels.org

High tunnels generally have steel pipe frames set into the ground and are covered with one or two layers of greenhouse-grade plastic. They are irrigated using drip systems, hand watering or small sprinklers. Roll-up sidewalls, usually hand cranked but sometimes automated, provide ventilation in hoop house construction. They may also have end-wall vents (louvers) or ridge vents.
